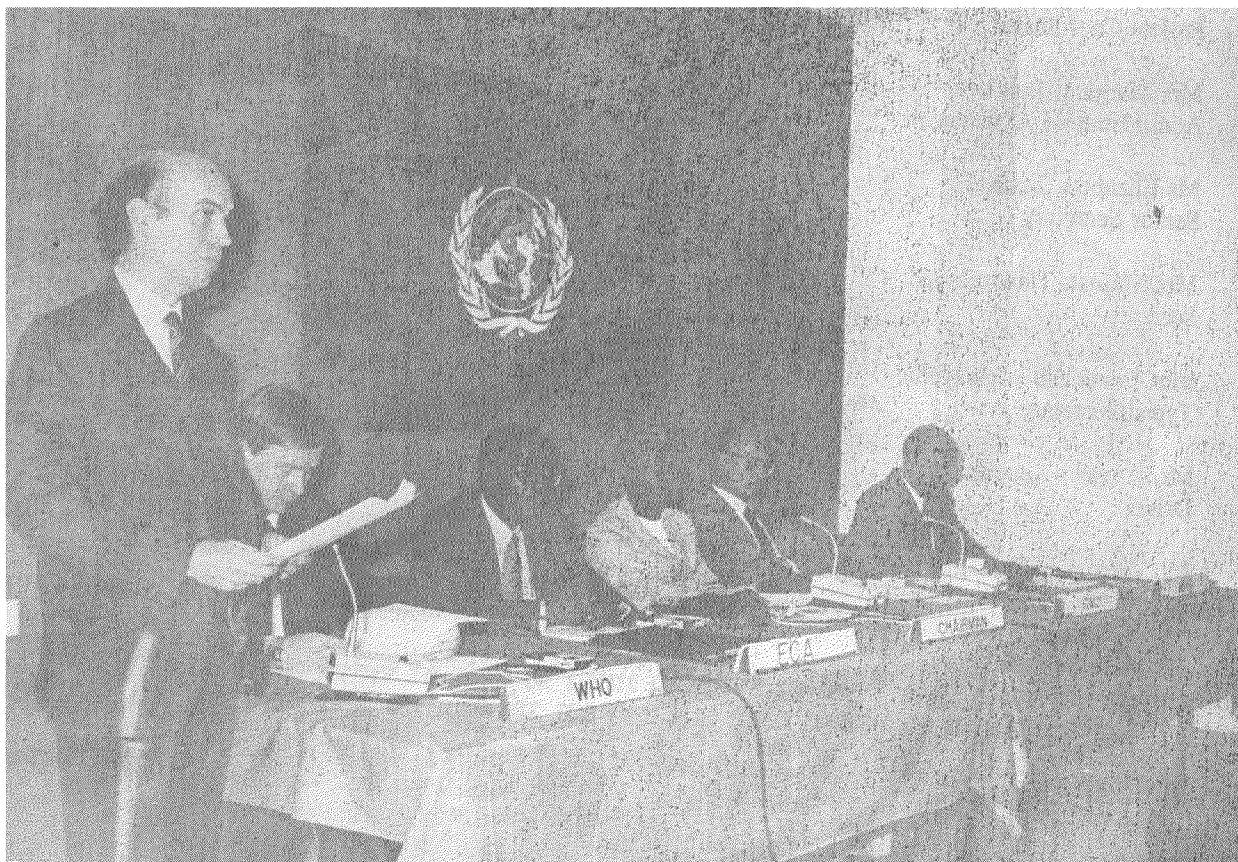

*During his previous assignments as development cooperation manager he has worked in and visited some 50 countries, of which 31 were in Africa. He is the author of six books and more than 200 articles on peoples participation in development with particular emphasis on leadership and managerial aspects.*

*Dr Calvani is Italian, 38 years old, married with four children; he has taken up his new assignment in Brazzaville, Congo as of January 1991. His new address is: WHO P.O. Box 6, Brazzaville, Congo. He continues to act as Director until May 1991 while the search for a new Director has been initiated.*

*The direction of the WHO Panafrican Centre for EPR has been entrusted to Dr Amin H. Salama Deputy Director, on an interim basis.*
