

PRINCIPLES AND RULES FOR DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION

Introduction

The General Assembly of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies authorized the implementation of new guidelines, in October 1989, the "Principles and Rules for Development Cooperation." To enable revisions to be made in the coming few months, the document has been termed "provisional".

The document is broken into four main sections:

- a) General Provisions;
- b) Priorities and Concerns for Development Assistance;
- c) Organization and Preparation at the National Level;
- d) Responsibilities for International Development Assistance;

Within the four main sections, there are twenty three segments.
